There are three different school supplies that I would like you to bring on the first day of school. Please bring a **backpack**, **water bottle** (should be spill proof and easy to open for students), and **headphones in a Ziploc bag** that can plug into a chrome book. **Please label each item with your name.** Make sure your headphones aren't too big, since they need to fit in your desk basket.
