Fiddlers Elementary is a School-Wide Title 1 School. The Title 1 program is a nationally funded program. Because we are school wide, we are allowed to use the funds to serve all students in the school. The amount of funds and the help we receive from the federal government depends on the percentage of students who qualify for free and reduced lunch.

The Title 1 program pays for Teaching Assistants that provide intervention groups, as well as our Extended Day Kindergarten Program.

As you can see, being a Title 1 School, gives us a definite advantage over a Non-Title 1 school. We receive many personnel that we would not receive without the Title 1 status. If you feel you could apply for free and reduced lunch, even if you do not use it, it would help our school. If you would like to apply, you can go to the district website. Go under departments and choose Nutrition. The website is right under nutrition, or you may go to www.heartlandapps.com.

You will receive the Fiddlers Elementary Parent Compact document. This document will be reviewed and approved by our Community Council. Please review the document when it is sent home and provide any input that you feel is necessary. For anyone who is interested in seeing the Fiddlers Title 1 plan, you may come, at any time, to the office and check with Mrs. Hall or Mrs. Reynolds.

According to the ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) parents have a right to know the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teacher. All teachers at Fiddlers Elementary at Fiddlers Elementary are highly qualified. If we were to have a teacher that was not highly qualified, Mrs. Hall would send home a letter to the parents of the students in that classroom.
